Comparative adjectives compare two or more people, things, or ideas; they end in *-er*.

Superlative adjectives compare more than two people, things, or ideas; they end in *-est*.

For words that end in silent *e*, drop the *e* before adding *-er* or *-est*.

For words that end in *-y*, change the *y* to *i* before adding *-er* or *-est*.

/aw/ is spelled *aw*, *au*, *augh*, *ough*, *all*, and *al* and makes the sound as in the word *taught*.
